



SINGLE DAY WHITE WATER RAFTING ON THE CLACKAMAS RIVER

Below is a summary of information you will need regarding your upcoming adventure with YD Adventures. If you have any questions, please feel free to give us a call. Our phone number is (503) 266-7622.

Rendezvous

You will meet your YD Adventures guides at the Get N Go convenience store in Estacada, one half hour before the time designated on your contract. We will shake hands, gather med/release forms, use the facilities and convoy to the take-out at the Memaloose weigh station on Hwy 224.

Directions to the Get N Go convenience store.

From anywhere in the Portland metro area take I-205 to the Hwy 212/224 exit to Mt.Hood and Estacada respectively. Follow Hwy 224 to Estacada. The Get N Go is on Hwy 224 near the east end of town on the right (south) side of the highway. In the same business 'strip' there is the Cazadero Inn on the right side of the highway. If you begin to head up river you've gone too far! ☺

Shuttle

You are responsible for your own shuttle. Be prepared to leave one of your vehicles at the take-out in order to transport drivers back to the put-in to retrieve your vehicles there at the end of the trip. YD Adventures will help by transporting as many people as possible in our van/vehicle(s) but it's doubtful we can transport them all. The shuttle takes about 35 minutes.

What to bring:

Swimsuit
Wool or synthetic socks
Wool or synthetic gloves
Wool or synthetic hat
2 upper body layers of polypropylene or synthetic insulation.
(One could be thin, like long john underwear and the other something like a sweater or pullover. **DO NOT BRING COTTON!** These two layers give choices for warmth depending on the weather and each person's metabolism.)
Change of clothes and towel
Snack or lunch if timing of trip warrants.
Sunglasses (Optional, but all eyewear should have a retaining device to prevent loss.)

For safety reasons we ask that you ask that members of your group refrain from bringing 'Dip Stick' water cannons and squirt guns.

More Info.

YD Adventures will supply neoprene booties, farmer john wet suits, waterproof splash jackets, PFD's (life jackets) and helmets.

At the beginning of the trip, YD Adventures' staff will collect from you the completely filled out medical release forms for each participant, signed by a parent/legal guardian (if the participant is under 18 years of age). The minimum age of participants rafting the Clackamas River is 14.

Each raft will hold up to 8 participants plus a YD Adventures guide. Participants will carry a paddle and help maneuver the boat down the river. A minimum of 6 participants is required to paddle a raft.

For safety reasons we must request that pregnant women remain ashore during the rafting season.

The YD Adventures staff has each raised their own support outside of any camper fees. They are committed to Christ and view their services to you as service to Christ. We know you will enjoy each other. The YD Adventures Staff will be the final authority on your expedition. They will appreciate your input and insights tremendously!
