



ROCK CLIMBING – BULO POINT

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Below is a summary of information regarding your upcoming rock climbing trip with YD Adventures. If you have any questions feel free to call us at (503) 266-7622.

Your trip begins at 9 A.M. and finishes around 5 P.M. that same day. Due to the amount of activity, these hours are not easily changed.

Each participant should bring loose fitting clothing, a wind breaker, sunglasses and tennis shoes (court shoes are best for climbing.) Don't forget a raincoat in case of bad weather.

We are required to collect medical release forms from each person, signed by a parent/guardian if the participant is under 18 years of age. Minimum age for participation is 11 years of age. **No exceptions can be made.**

Our rock climbing site is located at Bulo Point. You will meet your YD Adventure guides at Fifteen Mile Camp, just East of Mt. Hood at time indicated on your contract. Please see the map on the back of this form for directions.

Regardless of physical shape, rock climbing will be a challenge to all participants.

YD Adventures will provide all of the equipment, insurance and programming once you arrive for your day of rock climbing.

Along with YD Adventures highly trained and certified staff, we encourage you to bring several of your own staff along. This allows for quality follow-up and, because you will be fully participating, your group will see you as a learner, not just an authority.

You will need to provide for your own transportation and in the case of single day rock climbing trips, your own lunch as well.

The YD Adventures staff members on your trip have each raised their own support outside of any course fees. They are committed to Christ and view their services to you as service unto the Lord Jesus Christ. We know you will enjoy each other. The YD Adventures staff will be the final authority on your expedition. They will appreciate your input and insights tremendously.

DIRECTIONS TO FIFTEEN MILE CAMPGROUND AT BULO POINT

Fifteen Mile Campground is about a 2 hour drive from downtown Portland. It is just East of Mt. Hood in the Mt. Hood National Forest.

IF TRAVELING ON HWY 26

From the Portland Metro area take **HWY 26 EAST** past **Government Camp** to its junction with **HWY 35**.

(We'll call Government Camp "mile 0.")

Follow **HWY 35 NORTH** (7 miles past the Mt. Hood Meadows exit.) to junction with **HWY (Road) 44** (towards Dufur. Now you're at "mile 15.")

Follow HWY 44 approximately 8.5 miles and turn RIGHT onto Road 4420. (Now you're at "mile 23.5.") Look for the sign that says [Flag Point -> 7].

After one mile, the paved road will junction with a gravel road. **Follow the paved road** (veer to the right, up the hill.) **Continue almost 4 more miles to Fifteen Mile Campground** on the **LEFT**. You're there!

IF TRAVELING ON I-84

Follow I-84 EAST (to Hood River) and take Exit #64 to HWY 35.

Follow HWY 35 SOUTH approximately 26 miles to its junction with HWY (Road) 44 towards Dufur. (This junction/turn off is about 2 miles past Sherwood Campground.)

Follow HWY 44 about 8.5 miles and turn RIGHT onto Road 4420. (Now you're at "mile 23.5.") Look for a sign that says [Flag Point- → 7].

After one mile the paved road will junction with a gravel road. **Follow the paved road** (veer right, up the hill.) **Continue almost 4 more miles to Fifteen Mile Campground** on the **LEFT**. You're there! Welcome!
