



ROPE, ROCK, RAFT

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Eagle Fern Camp, Wasco & Deschutes River

Below is a summary of information you will need regarding your upcoming adventure with YD Adventures. If you have any questions feel free to call us at (503) 266-7622.

You will meet the YD Adventures staff on the grounds of Eagle Fern Camp. Please arrive a few minutes early so that we can look over the medical release forms. Directions to Eagle Fern Camp are on the back of this letter.

For **CAMPING** please bring:

Pile/synthetic clothing for wind/rain protection as cotton does not insulate when wet.	
Sleeping Bag	Warm casual outdoor clothing
Flashlight and batteries	Basic personal toiletries
Rain/wind pants and jacket	Wool socks and wool or pile sweater
Warm hat and gloves	Bible

For **CHALLENGE COURSE** please bring:

Sturdy, rubber soled shoes.
Loose fitting "Functional" is preferable to "Fashion" as we don't want to ruin nice clothing.

For **ROCK CLIMBING** please bring:

Loose fitting clothes	In case of challenging weather:
Tennis or court shoes	Rain/wind jacket and pants
	Wool socks and wool or synthetic pile sweater

For **WHITE WATER RAFTING** please bring:

Swimsuit and or shorts	Pile or synthetic sweater
Hat with a bill	Sunglasses with croakies
T-Shirt	Sturdy, shoes or sandals that won't fall off (no boots)
Sunscreen	Bug repellent

***For safety reasons please ask your group members to refrain from bringing "dip stick" water cannons or squirt guns.**

If you feel that members of your group may be bothered by cold water temperatures, "Farmer John" style wetsuits and booties are recommended. They will insure your warmth and can be provided by YD Adventures upon your request. While we understand the weather in Maupin is usually very warm, we recommend being prepared.

At the beginning of the trip YD Adventures staff will collect from you the completely filled out Medical/Liability Release Forms for each person, signed by a parent/legal guardian if the participant is under 18 years of age. These are required. **No exceptions can be made. Minimum age for participants is 11 years of age.**

Each raft will hold up to 10 people plus a YD Adventures Guide. Participants will constitute a paddle crew to help maneuver the boat down the river. A minimum of 6 participants are required to paddle a raft.

Unfortunately, for safety reasons, we must require pregnant women to remain ashore during the rafting season.

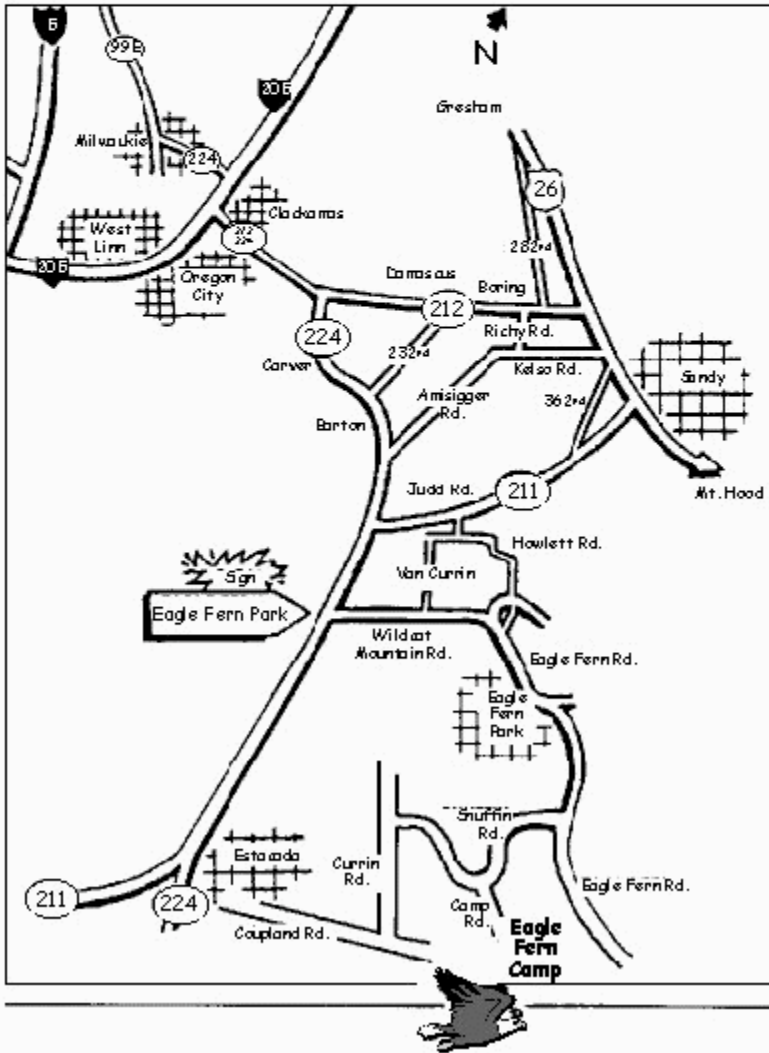

From I-205 take:

1. The Estacada Exit (12A) on to Highway 212/224 East
2. Highway 212/224 & proceed 3 miles to the Highway 212/224 junction, Alice's Country Market is on the South side of this intersection
3. A right on Highway 224 & proceed for 10.5 miles towards Estacada, 1 mile past the Eagle Creek Chevron Gas Station.
4. A Left on Wildcat Mountain Road (at the large sign for Eagle Fern Park) & proceed 1.8 miles
5. A Right at the Y in the road onto Eagle Fern Road & proceed 3 miles
6. A Right on Snuffin Road (which is 1/2 mile past Eagle Fern Park) and proceed 1/2 mile
7. A Left into the well-marked entrance to Eagle Fern Camp.

Note: Be cautious as you make this last turn, as it is located on a "blind" corner. A convex mirror high on the pole aids you in looking for oncoming traffic.

8. Follow Camp Road down into camp staying on the lower road.
